Main thought:

Jesus is the king who cares and who died on the cross for a purpose.

Ice-Breaker

- If you had to choose a job other than what you currently do, what would it be?
- Share a way you see God working in your life, or something He’s been teaching you.

Digging In

Read John 19:6-30 and discuss the following questions.

- What stood out to you from the passage?
- What is the significance of the sign Pilate posted on Jesus’ cross? What do you think people would have been thinking when they saw it?
- What is the significance of the soldiers dividing Jesus’ clothes and casting lots for His seamless robe? How does this fulfill Old Testament prophecy?
- While the soldiers are focused on what they can get, where is Jesus’ focus? Why is this meaningful?
- Why are Jesus’ final words on the cross so significant?
- If someone was to ask you why Jesus died on the cross, what would you tell them?
- What else stands out to you from this passage?

Application

- What is a key takeaway or personal application from this passage?

- How can we be praying for each other this week?
