## Main thought:

There are different ways you can approach Jesus, but the mark of a true follower of Jesus is that you have a growing faith.

## Digging In

Read John 4:43-45 and discuss the following questions.

- What stood out to you in these verses?
- Why did Jesus say that a prophet has no honor in his own country and yet when He arrived in Galilee the people welcomed Him?
- The principle shared from these verses is that a welcome isn't the same as credible faith. How is this an important caution for us to hear?

Read John 4:46-47 and discuss the following questions.

- What stood out to you in these verses?
- The principle shared from these verses is that God works in our troubles to develop crisis faith. How have you seen or experienced this in your life?

Read John 4:48 and discuss the following questions.

• The principle shared from this verse is that walking by sight leads to counterfeit faith. What does this mean? How can this happen?

Read John 4:49-52 and discuss the following questions.

- What stood out to you from these verses?
- The principle shared from these verses is that trusting God's Word leads to a confident faith. How does this man demonstrate that? How have you experienced this?



Read John 4:53 and discuss the following questions.

- What stood out to you from this verse?
- The principle shared from these verses is that our maturing faith achieves God's will-contagious faith. How do you see that in this story? How have you seen or experienced this in your life?
