- What is significant about Jesus' interaction with Peter and the changing of his name? (40-42). Discuss how Peter was transformed by Jesus beyond just his name. How does this encourage and challenge you?
- What can we learn from the fact that Jesus finds Philip and invites him to follow Him in verse 43?
- Who in this story do you relate with the most in terms of your own story of finding and following Jesus?
- Who is God putting on your heart? What will you do to help that person find and follow Jesus this week?
