Main thought:

In order to get Jesus right, we need to see Him for who he is, full of both grace and truth.

- Share about something or someone that you’ve been encouraged by recently.

Digging In

Read John 2:1-11, and discuss the following questions.

- What stood out to you from this portion of the passage?
- How is the statement from Mary to “do whatever he tells you” a good reminder for us too? What thoughts come to your mind when you hear this?
- How is the simple obedience of the servants rewarded in this passage? How is this a good reminder or encouragement in your life and circumstances?
- Why does Jesus do this miracle? What does it teach us about Jesus?

Read John 2:12-22, and discuss the following questions.

- What stood out to you from this portion of the passage?
- How is it helpful to see the friendly and familial interaction of Jesus in verse 12?
- What is behind Jesus’ righteous anger in verses 13-17?
- How is this picture of Jesus in the temple important to see alongside the picture of Jesus at the wedding?
- How is understanding Jesus being full of both grace and truth important for you personally?
- How is the apostle’s belief at the beginning of Jesus’ ministry and at the end of His ministry both helpful and challenging to see? (see verse 11 and verse 22)

Application

- How can you remember and apply the truths of this passage to your life this week?
