

Life Group Discussion Guide "The Coming of the Holy Spirit" – John 16:4-33 Scott Paulson – April 21, 2024

Main thought:

The coming of the Holy Spirit brings hope for the world and is a guide for the Church.

Notes:

Who is the Holy Spirit?

- 1. He is a <u>person</u>, not a <u>presence</u>.
- 2. He is truly <u>God</u>, not training to be <u>God</u>.
- 3. He is a guide, not a gallon.

Digging In

Read John 16:4-11, and discuss the following questions.

- What did Jesus tell the disciples before John 16:4? How does this tie into what Jesus tells them in the rest of chapter 16?
- Why is it for our benefit that Jesus goes away and that the Holy Spirit comes? (v. 7)
- In John 16:8-11, Jesus speaks about the Holy Spirit convicting the world of sin, righteousness, and judgment. How do you understand these concepts in today's context?

Read John 16:12-18, and discuss the following questions.

• Jesus promises the Holy Spirit as a guide. How have you experienced the guidance of the Holy Spirit in your life?

Read John 16:19-33, and discuss the following questions.

- Reflecting on John 16:21-22, Jesus compares the pain of childbirth to the joy of seeing a baby born. How have you experienced the Holy Spirit turning moments of pain into joy in your life?
- In verse 33, Jesus tells his disciples to take heart because he has overcome the world. How can we practically apply this encouragement to our daily lives and struggles?

• What else stood out to you that you can you apply from the passage this week?
