  - O What do these verses teach us about God's heart?
  - What does it look like for us to be aligned with God's heart in our lives?

#### Application (suggested time 10 minutes)

- What application did you most need to hear and apply from this message?
- Who specifically comes to your mind when it comes to be praying for, investing in, and inviting to take a next step toward Jesus?
- How will you be more inviting this week? As a church how can we be more inviting?
