I. A Healthy Church Has Spirit Filled Leaders.

Acts 13:1 (NKJV) Now in the church that was at Antioch there were certain prophets and teachers: Barnabas, Simeon who was called Niger, Lucius of Cyrene, Manaen who had been brought up with Herod the tetrarch, and Saul.

II. A Healthy Church Has Spirit Filled Ministry.

Four Characteristics of the Godly Men That Lead Antioch:

A. They were serving men.

Acts 13:2a (NKJV) As they ministered to the Lord...

B. They were seeking men.

Acts 13:2b (NKJV) As they ministered to the Lord and fasted...

C. They were sensitive men.

Acts 13:2 (NKJV) As they ministered to the Lord and fasted, the Holy Spirit said...

Principal: God never activates an inactive disciple.

D. They were selfless men.

Acts 13:3 (NKJV) Then, having fasted and prayed, and laid hands on them, they sent them away.

I find it interesting that God chose the best two men in the church to leave and carry His gospel to the world.

III. A Healthy Church Has a Spirit Filled Mission.

1 Corinthians 16:9 (NKJV) For a great and effective door has opened to me, and there are many adversaries.

Kent Hughes:

"There is a cost to serving Jesus Christ. Never share your faith, and you will never be called a fool. Never stand for righteousness on social issues, and you will never be rejected. Never bow your head in public to pray over your food, and you will never be laughed at. Never practice honesty in your business, and you will never lose your dishonest partners. Never reach out to the needy, and you will never be taken advantage of. Never give your heart to anyone, and it will never be broken. Never go to Cyprus, and you will never be subjected to a dizzy, heart-convulsing confrontation with Satan. Consequently, seriously follow Jesus Christ as a disciple, and you will experience a gamut of sorrows almost completely unknown to the unbeliever. But of course you will also know the joy of adventure with the Lord Jesus and of spiritual victory as you live a life of obedience to Him."
