- Read it as if it is true.

# Commissioning

## Try a Discovery Bible Study

- 1) Pray for VIPs to start a Discovery Bible Study with
- 2) Find a “person of peace”, someone who shows some openness to spiritual things.
- 3) Ask them if they would like to try reading the Bible with you.
- 4) If “yes”, ask if they know anyone else who might want to join in.
- 5) Set a time & place and do DBS with them.
- 6) After a couple times, ask the others to lead the next times
- 7) Encourage them to do it on their own. Encourage them to do it with others.
- 8) Coach/Mentor/Disciple them as they go.
- 9) Where to start/study? For not-yet-believers, consider a “Creation to Christ” overview study or one of the Gospels.
