
#### Sermon Notes November 5, 2023 "Holy Spirit Living: Worship"

Hebrews 13:15-16

1. We are meant to <u>only worship</u> God. (Rev. 22:8-9, John 4:23-24, Matt. 2:11, Rom. 12:1, Col 3:17, Heb. 13:15-16)
2. We are instructed in <u>how</u> to worship. (James 4:8, Heb. 12:14, Col. 3:16, Eph. 5:17-21, Ps. 24:1, Heb. 13:5)
3The acts are important, but they <u>must come</u> from the heart. (Isaiah 29:13)

#### Revelation 22:8-9

8 I, John, am the one who heard and saw these things. And when I heard and saw them, I fell down to worship at the feet of the angel who showed them to me, 9 but he said to me, "You must not do that! I am a fellow servant with you and your brothers the prophets, and with those who keep the words of this book. Worship God."

### John 4:23-24

<sup>23</sup> But the hour is coming, and is now here, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth, for the Father is seeking such people to worship him.

<sup>24</sup> God is spirit, and those who worship him must worship in spirit and truth."

#### Matthew 2:11

<sup>11</sup> And going into the house, they saw the child with Mary his mother, and they fell down and worshiped him.

#### Romans 12:1

I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship.


#### Colossians 3:17


<sup>17</sup> And whatever you do, in word or deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him.


## Ephesians 5:17-21
