2. Delayed by **JESUS**

C. Fifth Cup of ELIJAH

- 1. WRATH poured out
- 2. Jesus' cup of <u>SUFFERING</u>

OUR CUP OF COMMUNION (I Corinthians 11:26)

- 1. A participation
- 2. A proclamation
- 3. A memorial
- 4. An anticipation
