## THE PASSOVER WEEK

<i>Day</i>	<i>Duty</i>	<i>Divine Design</i>
Sunday	Choose the <b><u>LAMB</u></b>	Triumphal Entry
Monday	Sweep the <b><u>LEAVEN</u></b>	Cleanse the temple
Tuesday	<b><u>CERTIFY</u></b> the lamb	Interrogation in temple
Wednesday	<b><u>PLAN</u></b> the sacrifice	Concocting the betrayal
Thursday	<b><u>GALILEAN</u></b> Passover	The Last Supper
Friday	Lambs <b><u>SACRIFICED</u></b>	Crucifixion
Saturday	Sabbath <b><u>REST</u></b>	In the tomb
Sunday	<b><u>FIRSTFRUITS</u></b> celebrated	Resurrection !!

## THE LAST PASSOVER (Mark 14:12-26)

- A. Divine **PREPARATION** (14:12-16)  
-accommodation      -availability      -anonymity
- B. Divine **FOCUS** (14:17)  
-apostles      -teaching (John 13-17)
- C. Divine **COMPLETION** (14:18-26)
1. One **LAMB**  
-firstborn      -spotless      -unbroken
  2. Three **BREADS**  
-unleavened      -hidden      -found

3. Four **CUPS** (Ex. 6:6-8)
  - Sanctification
  - Deliverance
  - Redemption
  - Consummation

## **THE FIRST COMMUNION (14:22-25)**

- A. Third Cup of **REDEMPTION**
  1. Sacrificial: **BLOOD** poured out
  2. Binding: a **NEW** covenant
  3. Personal: For **YOU**
- B. Fourth Cup of **CONSUMMATION**
  1. Drank by the **APOSTLES**
  2. Delayed by **JESUS**
- C. Fifth Cup of **ELIJAH**
  1. **WRATH** poured out
  2. Jesus' cup of **SUFFERING**

## **OUR CUP OF COMMUNION (I Corinthians 11:26)**

1. A participation
2. A proclamation
3. A memorial
4. An anticipation
