Dental Clinic Report - Carmichael church partnered with the Life and Health Network to hold a free dental clinic from 8:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M. on Sunday, February 18 and Monday, February 19, 2024. The event was held in the Fellowship Hall, where the Life and Health Network set up ten portable dental chairs and ten portable dental delivery units.

Life and Health Network also provided all the necessary equipment, materials, supplies, and instruments needed for volunteer dentists, dental hygienists, and dental assistants to perform free fillings, extractions, and teeth cleanings.

On Sunday, there were 57 volunteers, and on Monday, there were 61 volunteers who helped out by registering patients, taking vital signs, screening patients, taking and viewing radiographs, providing childcare, directing patient flow, providing treatment, emptying the garbage, preparing meals for the volunteers, and praying with patients before they left the Fellowship Hall.

In all, 84 patients were treated on Sunday, and 71 patients received care on Monday, which comes out to 155 individuals from an under-served population who received free treatment because of the volunteer's efforts.

The patients were very grateful for the care they received and thanked the volunteers for providing this service.
