CHURCH FAMILY BUDGET

At the end of June 2022, our Church Family Budget deficit was approximately \$23,000. (Normal) This year that figure has skyrocketed to more than \$95,000, yet tithe is almost 112% of last year, which was a record year for tithe. If the current pace of giving continues, we will have a deficit at the end of the year of approximately \$160,000, our first deficit in the 19 years that this team has been at Carmichael. Beginning today, we will break down our budget each week so that members understand where the budgeted money goes. First and foremost is our commitment to Christian education.

From the 2023 Budget of \$702,828: Subsidy to Sacramento Adventist Academy - \$214,440 or 30.5% of the budget.
