Simple Guide: Your New Online Member Directory Login

Great news! The Online Member Directory app update will be released today. Please use the following very important information to help your members login.

To prepare for the new system, all users will have to set up a new way to log in.

VERY IMPORTANT FIRST STEP

Your old username and password **will NOT WORK** in the new system. All users must now log in with an **email address** and set up a **brand new password**.

Please follow these steps in order. Only move to the next step if the current step fails.

Step 1: Reset Your Password

If your existing account was successfully moved over, this is the quickest way to get started.

- 1. Go to the app.onlinememberdirectory.com on the website or the new app.
- 2. On the third page, click "Forgot Password" or try here under the login fields.
- 3. Enter your email address, the one listed on your directory profile.
- Check your email for a verification code email. (if you do not get an email with a code check your email for typos.)
- 5. Enter the verification code and set up your new password.

If you get an **error message that your account cannot be found** after resetting your password, please move on to Step 2.

Step 2: Create a New Account (Sign Up with Email)

If Step 1 did not work, it means the system couldn't find your account. Next, create a new account with your email.

- Go to <u>app_olinememberdirectory.com</u>, under the login button click "Dont have an account, sign up by **email.**"
- 2. Enter your email address to create your new account.
- 3. Enter your code and setup your new login credentials.
- 4. The system will automatically try to match your new account with your existing membership using your name and email.

If it matches, you will be all set!

If you receive an error, please move on to Step 3 to try signing up with your phone number.
