CHURCH FAMILY BUDGET

Last week we began to look at our budget of \$702,828 and where the money goes. The following are our two largest expenses.

Subsidy to Sacramento Adventist Academy 30.5%
Salaries and wages: 38.8%

Salaries and wages include the following: Facilities Administrator, Administrative Assistant, Church Treasurer, Custodians (one full-time--one part-time), Maintenance (part-time), Grounds (part-time), Music Coordinator, Worship Coordinator, and Organist.

Our deficit is approximately \$95,000. Your help in erasing this deficit is needed and appreciated.
