It Shall Come to Pass...

The Latter Days: The Era of Full and Complete Restoration of Creation Micah 4:1-8

1. The Reign and Worship of God will be Supreme (v.1)

It shall come to pass in the latter days that the mountain of the house of the LORD shall be established as the highest of the mountains, and it shall be lifted up above the hills

2. The ways will seem backward to the world (v.1b)

and peoples shall flow to it,

3. People from all nations will come (v.2a)

and many nations shall come, and say:
"Come, let us go up to the mountain of the LORD,
to the house of the God of Jacob

4. The Word will be desired, obeyed, and proclaimed (v.2b)

that he may teach us his ways and that we may walk in his paths." For out of Zion shall go forth the law, and the word of the LORD from Jerusalem.

5. There will be perfect justice (v.3a)

He shall judge between many peoples, and shall decide disputes for strong nations far away;

6. Instead of violence there will be fruitful work (v.3b)

and they shall beat their swords into plowshares, and their spears into pruning hooks; nation shall not lift up sword against nation, neither shall they learn war anymore;

7. All will dwell in peace and security (v.4)

but they shall sit every man under his vine and under his fig tree, and no one shall make them afraid, for the mouth of the LORD of hosts has spoken.

8. His people all walk in His ways (v.5)

For all the peoples walk
each in the name of its god,
but we will walk in the name of the LORD our
God forever and ever.

9. The Lord will gather and restore (v.6-7)

In that day, declares the LORD,
I will assemble the lame
and gather those who have been driven away
and those whom I have afflicted;
and the lame I will make the remnant,
and those who were cast off, a strong nation;
and the LORD will reign over them in Mount Zion
from this time forth and forevermore.

10. The Lord will establish dominion and kingship (v.8)

And you, O tower of the flock, hill of the daughter of Zion, to you shall it come, the former dominion shall come, kingship for the daughter of Jerusalem.

Micah 4:9-13

Grief and exile are coming...

⁹ Now why do you cry aloud?
Is there no king in you?
Has your counselor perished,
that pain seized you like a woman in labor?
¹⁰ Writhe and groan, O daughter of Zion,
like a woman in labor,
for now you shall go out from the city
and dwell in the open country;
you shall go to Babylon.

...but the Lord promises to redeem and restore.

There you shall be rescued; there the LORD will redeem you from the hand of your enemies.

The world will mock and scorn God's people...

¹¹ Now many nations are assembled against you, saying, "Let her be defiled, and let our eyes gaze upon Zion."

...but the Lord's plans will prosper.

12 But they do not know the thoughts of the LORD; they do not understand his plan, that he has gathered them as sheaves to the threshing floor.

13 Arise and thresh,
O daughter of Zion,
for I will make your horn iron,
and I will make your hoofs bronze;
you shall beat in pieces many peoples;
and shall devote their gain to the LORD,
their wealth to the Lord of the whole earth.

- "And he who was seated on the throne said, 'Behold, I am making all things new." Revelation 21:5


Not yet Fulfilled and full of Hardship

We are part of the inaugurated Kingdom as new creations in Christ

- o "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come." 2 Corinthians 5:17
- "He has delivered us from the domain of darkness and transferred us to the kingdom of his beloved Son." Colossians 1:13

We grieve in exile

- o "Elect exiles...conduct yourselves with fear throughout the time of your exile..." 1 Peter 1:1, 17
- "But our citizenship is in heaven, and from it we await a Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ..."
 Philippians 3:20
- "For here we have no lasting city, but we seek the city that is to come." Hebrews 13:14

We grieve with labor pains

- "When a woman is giving birth, she has sorrow because her hour has come, but when she has delivered the baby, she no longer remembers the anguish, for joy that a human being has been born into the world. So also you have sorrow now, but I will see you again, and your hearts will rejoice, and no one will take your joy from you." John 16:21-22
- "For we know that the whole creation has been groaning together in the pains of childbirth until now. And not only the creation, but we ourselves, who have the firstfruits of the Spirit, groan inwardly as we wait eagerly for adoption as sons, the redemption of our bodies." Romans 8:22-23

We are mocked and scorned by the world

 "If the world hates you, know that it has hated me before it hated you. If you were of the world, the world would love you as its own; but because you are not of the world, but I chose you out of the world, therefore the world hates you." John 15:18-19

The Lord Rescues and Redeems

- Through judgement and discipline
 - I will assemble the lame and gather those who have been driven away and those whom I have afflicted; (v.6)
 - There (from exile in Babylon) you shall be rescued; there (from exile in Babylon) the LORD will redeem you from the hand of your enemies. (v.10b)
- The place of exile and judgement becomes the place of deliverance.

"When Yahweh disciplines those who are his, the purpose is not retribution but discipline. Israel is assured that by going through the judgment/discipline, Yahweh will redeem them. Yahweh's discipline tears down their sin so that he can build them up in righteousness and holiness." -Joanna Hoyt

The Cross of Christ: the place of judgement becomes the place of redemption.

"...this Jesus, delivered up according to the definite plan and foreknowledge of God, you crucified and killed by the hands of lawless men. God raised him up, loosing the pangs of death, because it was not possible for him to be held by it." Acts 2:23-24

The Thoughts and Plans of the Lord will Prosper

"But they do not know the thoughts of the LORD; they do not understand his plan, that he has gathered them as sheaves to the threshing floor." (v.12)

"Does one crush grain for bread?
No, he does not thresh it forever;
when he drives his cart wheel over it
with his horses, he does not crush it.
This also comes from the Lord of hosts;
he is wonderful in counsel
and excellent in wisdom."
