

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

1. Where does unbelief subtly show up in our obedience? Where are we tempted to explain away fear, delay, or self-protection as “wisdom”? How does unbelief often masquerade as prudence in our lives?
2. How does God’s faithfulness in judgment encourage perseverance today? How does this passage correct both despair (“I’ve failed too much”) and presumption (“God will bless me anyway”)?
3. How do we distinguish repentance from regret? What are signs of true repentance versus emotional regret?
