## DISCUSSION QUESTIONS FOR GROUPS:

2. Does compassion come to you easily or not? Do you feel compassion even for distant people? Or do you tend to think "They brought their troubles on themselves"? Can we cultivate compassion?
3. When do you find it easy to call someone "My neighbor"? When is it hard?
4. Can you think of a person or group that you might begin to see as a neighbor?
