DISCUSSION QUESTIONS FOR GROUPS:

1.	What does the writer of Hebrews mean when he says it is fitting for Jesus that God "should make the pioneer of their salvation (Jesus) perfect through suffering?" Spend some time praising the plan of the Father and the work of the Son.
2.	Why is it good to have heroes? Who are your heroes and why? In what sense is Jesus your hero?
3.	How can a proper interest in heroes – especially Jesus, but other great people too – enrich our lives as believers and keep us on the right path? Follow-up: Have you ever followed an example unwisely?
4.	Are you afraid of dying? How does Jesus address and resolve the fear of death? Share some Biblical teachings that remove our fear of death.
