DISCUSSION QUESTIONS FOR GROUPS:

1. Why is it hard to make peace? How does the peace we have with God present the foundation for making peace with others? What practical steps can we take to make peace?
2. How do we unnecessarily cause ourselves pain and rob ourselves of peace? Why do we often guess the worst when trying to make sense of events?
3. Our passage has four prominent prohibitions, telling us how not to respond to sin, pain and evil. Can you list them? Why do we need each of them? Why do we need the four positive counterparts?
4. Why is it hard to forego revenge? Why should we leave judgment to God? How does it make life easier and better to do so?
