

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

1. How does God, to use C.S. Lewis's language, speak to us in our consciences and shout to us in our pains? How is He speaking to you in your life today?
2. What should we take away from this passage's teaching about how God sovereignly ordains the events of world history? How is that a comfort to us? What is difficult for us to accept in such teaching?
3. How has God's provision met your deepest need, even if it did not meet the need you felt was most urgent at the time? Can you think of particular examples?
