Small Group Guide: Treasures in Heaven By Pastor Anthony

Opening Prayer: Ask a volunteer to open the session in prayer, focusing on openness to God's word and wisdom in applying it to our lives.

Key Scripture: Matthew 6:19-21

Main Idea: True generosity is a reflection of the heart's priorities, revealing whether we seek to accumulate earthly wealth or build eternal treasures in heaven.

### Discussion Questions:

- 1. What stood out to you most from the sermon? Why?

- 5. The sermon mentions generosity as an act of worship and devotion. Share a time when you experienced joy in giving. How did it impact your faith?
- 6. What challenges do you face in breaking free from materialism? How can we support each other in embracing eternal values?
- 7. The pastor introduced "acts of kindness" cards. What are some creative ways we could use these to bless others in our community?
