subject: the cities of refuge & the cities of the Levites

objective: turn to Jesus for refuge & fulfillment

I. Jesus is my refuge (Joshua 20:1-9)

"Whoever sheds man's blood, by man his blood shall be shed; for in the image of God He made man." (Gen. 9:6)

A. we can always turn to Jesus for refuge

"God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble." (Psalm 46:1)

- 1. God has made it clear Who Jesus is and how to come to Him
- 2. Jesus is always reachable to the person in need
- 3. we can turn to Jesus when we're in crisis
- 4. Jesus is available to all
- 5. Jesus is the only way to be saved from our sin
- 6. our freedom was made complete thru Jesus' sacrificial death
- 7. even the guilty can come to Jesus and find refuge
- II. Jesus is my inheritance (Joshua 21:1-45)
- A. we can count on Jesus as our inheritance

"The Lord is my portion,' says my soul, 'therefore I hope in Him! The Lord is good to those who wait for Him, To the soul who seeks Him." (Lam. 3:24-25)

"My flesh and my heart fail; but God is the strength of my heart and my portion forever." (Psalm 73:26)
