## Joshua 24:1-33 "We Will Serve the Lord" Pastor Bruce Zachary

## **Discussion Qs**

- 1. How has God called you to Himself, protected, preserved, and provided?
- 2. What are some of the master passions [objects of worship (idols)] in our land?
- 3. How can we choose to serve God and still enjoy some of the objects of our affections in this world?
- 4. How might your choice of serving God impact your life in the coming season?

**intro.** There are certain seasons on life that are a catalyst for reflection: a birthday, anniversary, and the brink of a new year. It is an opportunity to consider what has been and to wonder what will be. A time to dream what we want it to be; and the choices that we make today will undoubtedly impact the experience of tomorrow ...

Subject: Israel renews their covenant with God

**Object: Commit your life to Christ** 

A. Consider: God is faithful [1-13] [Israel's history and the Promised Land]

- **v.1 Schechem:** Mountains of Ephraim, Joshua's tribe, where the Lord appeared to Abraham and gave the promise of the land [Gen.12:6], and where Joshua renewed the covenant with the people after victory at Ai [Josh 8]. Now 20-30 yrs later
- v.2 Thus says the Lord: God's message to His people, not merely Joshua's
- 1. God's promise [2-4] Abraham and the Patriarchs & the Promised Land
- a. Call to separate from false gods to the true and living God. God brought Abraham to the PL, gave Isaac [3-4] and brought Jacob and his 12 sons to Egypt [4]
- 2. God's protection [5-7] God sent Moses and Aaron, the plagues and parted the

Red Sea to deliver Israel from Egypt. Proved Lord is God, not pagan gods of Egypt.

- **3. God's preservation [8-10]** God gave Israel victories and blessed them in the wilderness [Balak, Balaam **Num.22-25**].
- **4. God's provision [11-13]** God gave them conquest of the PL; gave them victory, cities, dwellings, orchards and vineyards.
- ? How has God called you to Himself, protected, preserved, and provided?

- B. Choose: whom will you serve? [14-21]
- 1. A challenge to serve the Lord [14-15] Now therefore, fear the LORD, serve Him in <u>sincerity and in truth</u>, and <u>put away the gods</u> which your fathers served on the other side of the River and in Egypt. <u>Serve the LORD</u>! [Jn. 4:23-24]
- a. A call to reverently worship God serve Him in sincerity + truth, put-away idols
- i. The conquest was complete, tend towards apathy in re with God after battle ...
- ii. Joshua reminds Israel of God's faithfulness to encourage a renewed commitment
- b. A choice must be made [15] And if it seems evil to you to serve the LORD, choose for yourselves this day whom you will serve, whether the gods which your fathers served that *were* on the other side of the River, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land you dwell.
- i. We all serve someone or something. Choose wisely because you become like what you worship [Ps. 115:1-8].
- **1Ki. 18:21-39** Elijah challenges the people to choose between God and Baal, but no response till God proved [Cf. Resurrection] **Matt. 16**
- c. A leader's choice declared [15] But as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD:
- i. Joshua is committed to God regardless of what others choose
- Ii. Affirms his leadership not only in the congregation but his family.
- Jn. 6:68 [Peter] Lord to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life.
- 2. The people's choice confirmed [16-18] Israel affirms their decision
- **a.** The people realize God's past faithfulness to their generation & generation(s) that preceded them. Therefore affirm they also will serve the YHWH for He is our God [18]
- 3. The caution communicated [19-21] consider the consequences
- **a.** Joshua cautions the people to be serious about their commitment because of the consequences forsaking the Lord [19-20], and the people affirm they will serve the Lord [21]
- C. Commit: the covenant renewed [22-28]
- 1. Repent: since you have chosen the Lord put away idols and turn to the Lord [22-23]
- 2. Renew: a sacred agreement to serve the Lord [24-25]
- 3. Remember: copy of the covenant & large stone were witnesses to covenant [26-28]
- Rev. 2:1-7 Tendency to lose passion and the need to prioritize Christ
- D. Commemorate: remember the people who have served and influenced you for God [29-33] Death of Joshua and Eleazar + burial of Joseph

- 1. Joshua: legacy servant of the Lord [29], Israel served Lord all his days [29-31]
- a. Joshua was 110 when he passed [29]
- 2. Joseph: honored re bones buried in the Promised Land [32],Gen.50:25, Heb.11:22]
- 3. Eleazar: High Priest, son of Aaron, died and was buried [33]. Phineas became HP
