subject: Jesus has provided a better sacrifice objective: accept His sacrifice & anticipate His return

I. the Old Covenant was imperfect (vv. 1-10)

covenant = legal agreement between two or more parties

- A. it's tabernacle (vv. 1-5)
- B. it's priestly services (vv. 6-7)
- C. it's imperfections (vv. 8-10)
- 1. it wasn't the way to God (8)
- 2. it wasn't the real thing (9)
- 3. it wasn't effective (9-10)

II. Jesus established a New Covenant (vv. 11-22)

- A. it's superiority (11-15)
- 1. it's perfect tabernacle: heaven (11)
- 2. it's perfect offering: the blood of Jesus (12-14)
- 3. it's perfect results: redemption & eternal inheritance (15)
- B. it's requirement (vv. 16-22)
- 1. death (Rom. 6:23)

III. the New Covenant is based on Jesus' better sacrifice (vv. 23-28)

- A. He sacrificed Himself once and for all (23; 25-26; 28)
- B. He appears before God for us (24)
- C. He's coming again (27-28)
