

## Psalm 51:1-19

“Repent, be Restored, and Rejoice!”

subject: David’s prayer of repentance

objective: repent, be restored, & rejoice

### I. repentance (vv. 1-6)

note: the gravity of our sin

#### A. conviction (vv. 1-2)

1. when we feel the conviction of the Holy Spirit, we shouldn’t ignore it

#### B. confession (vv. 3-6)

1. there is no cleansing without confession

### II. restoration (vv. 7-12)

note: the graciousness of God’s forgiveness

#### A. cleansing (vv. 7-9)

1. only faith in Jesus Christ cleanses us from sin

#### B. change (vv. 10-12)

1. believers can grieve (Eph. 4:30) & quench (1 Thess. 5:19) the Holy Spirit

### III. rejoicing (vv. 13-19)

note: the gratitude in our hearts

#### A. proclaim (v. 13)

1. when our hearts are right before God, we can tell others about Him with integrity

#### B. praise (vv. 14-15)

1. experiencing God’s loving forgiveness causes us to praise Him

#### C. please (vv. 16-19)

1. ritual without repentance will be rejected
