Ps.78:1-8,70-72 "Telling the Next Generation"
Intro. How can parents teach their kids about God?

Subject: A history of Israel's rebellion and God's grace
Object: Prepare the next generation to be faithful to God

Theme: the Psalmist reviews Israel's history of rebellion despite God's grace to warn of the consequences, and encourage us to responsibly prepare the next generation.

A. Learn from history [1-4]

- 1. Pay attention and learn [1-2] Give ear, O my people, to my law; incline your ears to the words of my mouth, 2 I will open my mouth in a <u>parable</u>; I will utter <u>dark sayings</u> of old: the psalmist is going to tell us a history lesson to teach us a moral, a deeper meaning (ie. purpose beyond knowing the history of Israel).
- 2. Take responsibility to tell the next generation about God [3-4] 3which we have heard and known, and our fathers have told us. 4we will not hide *them* from their children, telling to the generation to come the praises of the LORD, and His strength and His wonderful works that He has done.
- a. an ideal: receive from your parents and teach to your kids [3] Grandparents, parents, children
- b. tell the next generation [4]: bridge, youth ministries, children's ministries
- i. **praises of the Lord:** His attributes worthy of worship, praise
- ii. His strength: greatness, power, majesty
- iii. His wonderful works: What God did for Israel [& what God has done in your life]
- ? What has God done in your life that would encourage others to trust Him?
- 3. The summary of Israel's history is to prepare the next generation[9-70] The psalmist chronicles the deliverance from Egypt the plagues and parting of the Red Sea; through the wilderness and 40 years of God's protection and provision (water, quail, manna) contrast with Israel's complaining, murmuring, and lack of trust, to the Promised Land and Israel's conquest and subsequent idolatry. The correction of God and His judgment is balanced with grace.
- a. The moral: be faithful to God and you will be blessed
- B. Learn from the Scriptures [5-8]
- a. God has given the Bible to prepare the next generations [5-6]

5For He established a <u>testimony in Jacob</u>, and <u>appointed a law</u> in Israel, which <u>He commanded</u> our fathers, that they should make them known to their children; <u>6That the generation to come might know them</u>, the children who would be born, that they may arise and <u>declare them</u> to their children, Eph.6:4 And you, fathers, do not provoke your children to wrath, but bring them up in the training and admonition of the Lord.

Deut.6:4-9 premiere prayer of Judaism & command re teaching the next gen

- b. That the next generation shall:
- i. Find their hope in God [7] that they may set their hope in God:
- ii. Not forget the works of God [7] and not forget the works of God:
- iii. Obey God and not rebel [7-8] but keep His commandments; 8 and may not be like their fathers, a stubborn and rebellious generation, a generation *that* did not set its heart aright, and whose spirit was not faithful to God.
- c. The moral: obey God and you will be blessed, rebel and suffer consequences
- C. Learn from David [70-72] [A picture of Christ-like leadership] the selection of Judah, Jerusalem [Zion] and David set the stage for God's grace restoration and hope [68-72]
- 1. Chosen [70] He also chose David: 1 Sam.16:11, [chosen to lead kids, next gen.] a. Jesus is the Chosen One [Is.42:1]
- 2. Servant [70] His servant: the goal of a servant is to please their master, Mk.10:45
 * parents serve their children; * love flows down
- 3. Shepherd [70-72] And took him from the sheepfolds; 71From following the ewes that had young He brought him, to shepherd Jacob His people, and Israel His inheritance. 72So he shepherded them: lead, protect, nurture, care for, Jn 10:
- 4. Integrity [72] according to the integrity of his heart: model Christ-like behavior
- **a.** morality is avoiding doing the wrong thing, character is doing the right thing even when difficult, and integrity is morality + character [Gal.5:22-23]
- 5. Skill [72] And guided them by the skillfulness of his hands: wisdom [Lu.2:52
