What are some reasons why God is worthy to be praised?

Subject: The Sovereignty of the LORD in Creation and History

Object: Praise the Lord

I. The call to praise the Lord [1-3]

1<u>Rejoice</u> in the LORD, O you righteous! *For* praise from the upright is <u>beautiful</u>. 2Praise the LORD with the harp; Make melody to Him with an instrument of ten strings. 3<u>Sing</u> to Him a new song; Play skillfully with a shout of <u>joy</u>.

- A. Joyful praise from God's people is beautiful: joy 2x
- 1. New song: nature vs. chronology, song of redeemed, song of those forgiven of sin
- ? What are some reasons why saved people praising God in song is beautiful?
- **2. play skillfully:** good exhortation and aspiration [*worship auditions, 12+ teams a. cf. should our praise depend on the skill level of the musicians or the vocalists, or the style of music?
- II. Why the Lord should be praised [4-22]
- A. The Lord is Creator [4-9]
- 1. The Lord loves truth, justice and righteousness [4-5] For the word of the LORD is right, And all His work is done in truth. 5He loves righteousness and justice;
- 2. The Lord's Creation is full of His goodness [5] The earth is full of the goodness of the LORD.
- ? What are some examples of the goodness of the Lord? [5]
- 3. The Lord created the heavens [6] By the word of the LORD the heavens were made, and all the host of them by the breath of His mouth.
- 4. The Lord separates the oceans from the land [7] 7He gathers the waters of the sea together as a heap; He lays up the deep in storehouses.
- 5. The Lord should be revered by all because He is good and Creator [8-9] 8Let all the earth fear the LORD; let all the inhabitants of the world stand in awe of Him. 9For He spoke, and it was *done;* He commanded, and it stood fast.
- B. The Lord is Sovereign [10-11] 10The LORD brings the counsel of the nations to nothing; He makes the plans of the peoples of no effect.11The counsel of the LORD stands forever, the plans of His heart to all generations.
- C. The Lord blesses [12] 12Blessed *is* the nation whose God *is* the LORD, the people He has chosen as His own inheritance.
- D. The Lord is all knowing and powerful [13-17]
- 1. Omniscient (all-knowing) [13-15] 13The LORD looks from heaven; He sees all the sons of men.14From the place of His dwelling He looks on all the inhabitants of the earth; 15He fashions their hearts individually; He considers all their works.

- 2. Omnipotent (all-powerful) [16-17]
- a. No power of this earth is sufficient nor can withstand

16No king *is* saved by the multitude of an army; A mighty man is not delivered by great strength.17A horse *is* a vain hope for safety; Neither shall it deliver *any* by its great strength.

E. Rejoice in the Lord because he gives life to those who trust in Him

18Behold, the eye of the LORD *is* on those who fear Him, On those who hope in His mercy, 19To <u>deliver their soul from death</u>, And to keep them alive in famine. 20Our <u>soul waits for the LORD</u>; He *is* our help and our shield. 21For our heart shall rejoice in Him, Because we <u>have trusted in His holy name</u>. 22Let Your mercy, O LORD, be upon us, Just as we hope in You.
