Psalm 22:1-31 "The Victorious Sufferer"

subject: the suffering and victory of the King objective: trust Jesus in suffering & experience victory

- I. the suffering of the King (1-21a)
- A. He feels forsaken & despised (vv. 1-11)
- 1. when we feel alone & abandoned, we can remember Jesus felt this way, too
- 2. in the midst of suffering, we need to recall how God has been faithful in the past
- B. He feels surrounded & weak (vv. 12-21a)
- 1. in spite of how we feel, we need to keep praying to the Lord
- II. the victory of the King (21b-31)
- A. praise with His people (vv. 21b-26)
- 1. when the Lord answers our prayers, we need to remember to praise Him
- B. worship of the nations (vv. 27-31)
- 1. one day we will join with all believers to worship the Lord
