TO LEAVE A LEGACY:

#1 We must reach the next generation.

- How does Paul set an example for us regarding reaching the next generation?
- What emphasis did Jesus place on children, and why (e.g. Matthew 18:1-6)?
- Why is it critical to have a passion to reach young people with the Gospel?
- The largest percentage of people who respond to the Gospel, do so before the age of 18. How should that reality impact individual Christians and the Church?

#2 We must teach the next generation.

- Read 2 Timothy 2:2. What was Paul's discipleship plan for Timothy?
- Read 1 Timothy 4:6-16. What was Paul's encouragement to Timothy?
- What did Jesus say we are to teach in the Great Commission (i.e. Matthew 28:18-20)?
- Every Christian is called to make disciples. What does that mean and how is it best done?

#3 We must beseech God for the next generation.

- Read 2 Timothy 1:2-3, 6-7. What do these verses tell us about the importance of prayer in Paul's life for Timothy?
- Read 2 Timothy 1:4-5. What kind of legacy of faith did Timothy have, and why is it important?
- Why is prayer critical to reaching and teaching the next generation (e.g. Matthew 9:35-38)?
- How can you be more intentional in reaching, teaching, and beseeching for those in the next generation?
