BUILT DIFFERENT

Big Idea: Spiritual gifts were never meant to create confusion, pride, or division, but to build up the church through humble, Spirit-filled service. Why do you think spiritual gifts create so much confusion or controversy among Christians?

THE SPIRIT GIVES GIFTS TO EVERY BELIEVER (Romans 12:6)

- Why is it dangerous to elevate personal experiences or “revelation” above Scripture?
- How does knowing every believer has the Holy Spirit affect the way we view ourselves and others in the church?
- What is the difference between spiritual gifts and the fruit of the Spirit?

THE GIFTS ARE DIFFERENT BUT EQUALLY NECESSARY (Romans 12:6-8)

- Why does God build the church with different gifts instead of making everyone the same?
- Which spiritual gift mentioned in this passage do you most naturally admire in others?
- How does diversity of gifts strengthen the church body?

Prophecy: Why is it important that all spiritual impressions or encouragements remain submitted to Scripture?

Serving: Why are serving gifts often overlooked or undervalued?

Teaching: Why is sound Biblical teaching especially important today?

Encouragement: Why do people naturally gravitate toward encouragers?

Generosity: How have you experienced joy through generosity?

Leadership: What makes biblical leadership different from worldly leadership?

Mercy: Why is “the ministry of presence” so powerful?
