

# ROMANS 12:18

## BIBLICAL PEACE

*Big Idea: Because we have peace with God through Jesus Christ, believers must pursue biblical peace with others without compromising the truth of God's Word.*

### PURSUE BIBLICAL PEACE

- What does Paul mean by the phrase, "if possible," and why is relational peace not always attainable? (e.g. Psalm 34:14; Matthew 18:15-17; Hebrews 12:14)
- How does the Bible distinguish between being a peacekeeper who avoids conflict and a peacemaker who lovingly pursues reconciliation? (e.g. Matthew 5:9; James 3:17-18; Romans 14:19)
- Jesus is called the "Prince of Peace," yet His ministry often created division. How do His life and teachings help us understand the difference between sinful conflict and conflict that results from faithfully proclaiming the truth? (e.g. Isaiah 9:6; Matthew 5:10-11, 10:34-39)

### PROTECT BIBLICAL PEACE

- Why can true biblical peace never be achieved by compromising God's truth? (e.g. John 17:17-23; Ephesians 4:1-6, 15; Jude 3)
- How can believers lovingly stand firm in biblical conviction while demonstrating the grace of Christ without becoming quarrelsome or argumentative? (e.g. 2 Timothy 2:24-26; 1 Peter 3:15-17)

### PRACTICE BIBLICAL PEACE

- What does Paul mean by the phrase, "So far as it depends on you"? How does this free believers from trying to control the hearts and actions of others while still calling us to faithful obedience? (e.g. 1 Peter 3:8-11)
- What practical steps can believers take to pursue peace while demonstrating humility, forgiveness, and Christlike love in strained relationships? (e.g. Philippians 2:3-4; Ephesians 4:31-32; Colossians 3:12-15)
- Since God pursued peace with us while we were still His enemies, how should the gospel shape our willingness to forgive, seek reconciliation, and entrust unresolved conflict to the Lord? (e.g. Romans 5:1-11; Colossians 1:19-22; 2 Corinthians 5:18-20)

*Closing Thought to Consider: Biblical peace is not peace at any price. It is peace on God's terms, in God's way, and for God's glory.*
