

JOHN 1:35-51

PUT IT ON REPEAT

BELIEVE

- What did these men believe about Jesus (e.g. John 1:41, 45, 49)?
- What must a person believe about Jesus in order to be saved?
- What's the difference between general faith and saving faith?
- Give careful attention to Jesus' interaction with Nathanael in vv. 47-51.
 - What did Jesus mean in v. 47?
 - What does v. 48 reveal about Jesus and how did that impact Nathanael (see vv. 49-50)?
 - Compare vv.50-51 with Genesis 28:10-22. How was Jesus the fulfillment of Jacob's dream and how did that apply to what He told Nathanael in v. 51.

FOLLOW

- The call to be a disciple of Jesus can be summed up in two words, "Follow Me." What does it mean to follow Jesus (e.g. Luke 9:23-27)?
- When Jesus told these men to follow Him, what did they give up and what did they gain?
- When did you begin following Jesus, and what have been some blessings and challenges as you have followed Him?

FIND

- As people began following Jesus (John 1:35-51), they also went and found others and brought them to Jesus. Why does this reveal and why is it important for all followers of Jesus to do this?
- We know very little about Andrew, but when we see him in the Scripture, he is always bringing people to Jesus. Who do you know that is like Andrew and how can you be more intentional about bringing people to Jesus?

REPEAT

- The Christian life is about believing in Jesus, following Jesus, and finding others to bring to Jesus. Why should this model/pattern be on repeat in every Christian's life? Why is it often not?
