- Read John 16:25-33. What did Jesus mean in v. 25?
- What is the doctrine of the Priesthood of the Believer, and why is this such an important reality in the Christian life (see Hebrews 4:14-16; 10:19-22)?
- What powerful truth were the disciples declaring in v. 30?
- Focus on v. 33. Where is a Christian's peace found?
- How does knowing Jesus has overcome the world, fill our hearts with steadfast hope?
