A FAITHFUL WITNESS POINTS TO JESUS

- Read John 1:19-28. Why did the religious leaders want to know who John the Baptist was?
- Where is the Old Testament prophecy of John 1:23 and how did John the Baptist fulfill it?
- Pay attention to John 1:27. What did that attitude represent about John the Baptist and why do we need the same attitude today?

A FAITHFUL WITNESS TESTIFIES ABOUT JESUS

- Read John 1:29-34. Why did John the Baptist use the phrase, "Behold the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world?"
- Why did John the Baptist baptize Jesus (see Matthew 3:13-17) and what did it reveal?
- Compare John 1:34 with John 20:31. As we defend the faith and call people to the faith, why is it important that we, like John, "have seen and borne witness" that Jesus is the Son of God?

A FAITHFUL WITNESS WALKS WITH JESUS

- Read John 1:35-37. What was John's primary message (see Matthew 1:1-12) and how did they prepare people for Jesus?
- Jesus didn't need John the Baptist's validation, but why was it important?
- The Christian life can be summed up in two words, "Follow Jesus." What does it mean and look like to follow/walk with Jesus?
