Chapter 9

1. What two changes concerning animals came after the flood? Mankind could use animals for food, animals would fear mankind.
2. Genesis 9:4 – “But flesh with the life thereof, which is the blood thereof, shall ye not eat.”
3. What covenant did God make in Chapter 9? Noahic
4. What were the “terms” of this covenant? Man was responsible to govern the world for God, God blessed Noah and his family, they were to fill the earth, God promised never again to use a universal flood to judge the world.
5. What sign did God give of this covenant? The rainbow.
6. Which of Noah’s sons is the father of the Canaanites? Ham
7. Which of Noah’s sons is the father of the Israelites? Shem
8. How long did Noah live after the flood? 350 years.

BONUS

1. What was the curse of Canaan? Canaanites were cursed to be “a servant of servants.”

Chapter 10

1. The term “Gentiles” was applied to the descendants of which of Noah’s sons? Japheth.
2. What does Nimrod’s name mean? “Let us rebel”
3. Nimrod was known as a mighty hunter.
4. Why did God allow the descendants of Ham to become both so powerful and so evil? So He could show His own power by defeating them and so He could sovereignly use them to chasten Israel when they disobeyed.

BONUS

1. What three verses in Genesis 10 indicate that this chapter was written after the Dispersion? How do we know this? Verses 5, 20 and 31. All refer to “after his (or their) tongues.” Before the Dispersion everyone spoke the same language.
