4. What was at hand? The time. (These truths are both upon us and imminent).
5. Who gave the revelation and where did John receive and write this book from? God gave it through God the Son Jesus Christ from the Isle of Patmos where John was exiled
6. Two times we see John's ministry was to bare record of the Word of God and to give Testimony to Jesus Christ (1:2, 1:9).
7. T or F: The Apostle John was eyewitness to the life and ministry of Jesus Christ. (1:2)
8. Who did John write this letter unto? The 7 churches of Asia Minor.
