## Foundations of the Faith Lesson 8: "Atonement For Sin"

- 1. At One Ment At One With God. Through Christ the sinner becomes AT ONE with God.
- 2. <u>Sin</u> separates fallen <u>man</u> from holy <u>God</u>.
- 3. What is used 447 times in the Bible in 375 verses? Spoken of first in Genesis 4:10 and finally in Rev. 19:13. It is synonymous with Life. What is it? Blood.
- 4. Through the Atonement of Christ, we have been saved from the following: 1. The Penalty of Sin, 2. The Power of Sin, The Presence of Sin
- 5. The Bible indicates at least 3 reasons that God wanted to save sinners. 1. It demonstrates the Love of God, 2. The Salvation of sinners displays the Grace of God throughout all eternity, 3.

  God also wanted a people who would do good works in this life and thus give the world a glimpse, albeit imperfect, of God who is good.
- 6. Clearly the Bible teaches that Christ's sacrifice was not a matter of <u>sympathy</u> but of substitution.
- 7. Redemption means liberation because of a payment made. To Believers the concept has a special significance since the payment was <u>the death of the Lord Himself</u>.
- 8. Propitiation means the placating of the personal wrath of God.
- 9. The Benefactor. "For He".
  - The S<u>ubstitute</u>. "...hath made Him to be sin for us who knew no sin" The Beneficiaries. "... for us"
  - The Benefits. "that we may be made the Righteousness of God in Him"
- 10. Jesus purchased the Church by His Blood.
- 11. Jesus ascended into Heaven and sat down at the right hand of the Father eternally making <u>intercession</u> for us with His <u>blood</u>, by His <u>resurrection</u>!
