1. List the four Churches addressed in Revelation 2 in order: Ephesus, Smyrna, Pergamos, Thyatira
2. Which of these churches had no condemnation? Smyrna
3. Fill in the blanks to the common way the letters to the 7 churches were closed out: "He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches."
4. What are the four levels of understanding within these letters? Local (actual churches), admonition for all churches in general, personal application, history of the Church.

5. **First church addressed in Revelation 2:** Ephesus
6. What is this church known as? The Loveless Church
7. What does its name mean? "my beloved," "my darling," or "the desired one," possibly relaxation
8. Rev. 2:1 describes the Correspondent as "he that holdeth the seven stars in his right hand, who walketh in the midst of the seven golden candlesticks."
9. Who is believed to have founded this church? Aquila and Priscilla & Paul
10. This city was the center of worship for what false deity? Artemis (Diana)
11. Name three things this church was commended for: Patience, refused to tolerate evil men, spiritual discernment, perseverance, hated the deeds of the Nicolaitans.
12. What is the condemnation of this church? Left their first love
13. What is the command given to this church? Remember, Repent, Return
14. Rev. 2:7 gives the counsel for this church. "To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the tree of life, which is in the midst of the paradise of God."
15. The church seems to align historically with the apostolic era of the First Century.

1. Christ opens most salutations to the 7 churches and highlights a description from Revelation 1 and the Vision of Christ and incorporates a different component that is pertinent to the individual church.

17. What is this church known as: The Suffering Church
18. What does its name mean? "Myrrh"
19. The Correspondent: "the first and the last which was dead, and is alive"
20. T / F Scripture does not record the founding of this church.
21. T / F This city still exists today as the Turkish city of Izmir.
22. The Commendation: This church stood strong for Christ in the face of Pressure, Poverty and Persecution.
23. What is the condemnation of this church? No condemnation
24. Christ's command to this city is to "Fear none of those things which thou shalt suffer"
25. The Counsel (Rev. 2:11): "He that overcometh shall not be hurt of the second death."
26. This was the crushed, constant, returning to compromise and crowned church!

Bonus:

1. What do the ten days of tribulation of Revelation 2:10 possibly refer to? Ten Roman emperors that persecuted the church.
2. Who was the first day referring to, the last day and who was one who was put to death during this era? First – Nero, Tenth – Diocletian, & Polycarp
