### NUMBERS 32

1. What 2 ½ tribes chose not to go into the Promised Land? Reuben, Gad, ½ tribe of Manasseh.
2. What was the reason they did not want to go into the Promised Land? Good pasture land for cattle
3. What phrase in Number 32:5 was very indicting? Bring us not over Jordan
4. How did Moses respond? Angrily, for their lack of faith and discouragement to their brethren
5. What was the response of the 2 ½ tribes? We will build cities here, then go with you and help to conquer the Promised Land.
6. What did Moses tell them would happen if they did not keep their word? Be sure your sin will find you out
7. How did Moses use their own words? By your own words you shall be held accountable
8. What land did the 2 ½ tribes claim (kings and lands)? Sihon of the Amorites and Og of Bashan
