- 2. What did he do there that he had done previously? <u>He called upon the name of</u> the Lord.
- 3. What was Lot's mistake in choosing the plain of Jordan? <u>He chose with his eyes</u> without seeking God's will; he chose selfishly instead of deferring to Abram, who since he was older, should have had first choice.
- 4. What was God's response to Abram after he and Lot separated? <u>"Lift up your eyes." God repeated the promises he made to Abram.</u>
- 5. To where did Abram move his tent and what did he do there? To the plain of Mamre, and he built an altar.
