#### Dare To Go in Faith with Confidence

1. Dare to go in Faith with the **truth** and the **Holy Spirit**.

#### **REVIEW IT**

Two of the words that summarize Jesus' message are: "Come!" and "Go!" We come to Jesus in faith and we go in faith and build God's kingdom. Our role in God's family is to invite others to join us. We can confidently share our faith as we remember that we have the truth and the Holy Spirit. We can go in faith with a spirit of Love, with humility, with questions and stories to tell, and to invite them to worship. As we lovingly listen to a person's heart, to their deep unmet needs or hidden hurts, we can share the hope we have in Christ.

- 4. Look over the six points on the outline. Which one is most meaningful to you?
