Promises... Promises...

After He said this, He was taken up before their very eyes, and a cloud hid Him from their sight. They were looking intently up into the sky as He was going, when suddenly two men dressed in white stood beside them. "Men of Galilee," they said, "why do you stand here looking into the sky? REVIEW IT

Jesus is coming again! It is the Blessed Hope and promise to which all creation is looking forward. He will return so that He can be with us and we can be with Him. But, the question isn't, are we living in the last days? The truth is, we are living in the only days we will ever have. The purpose of biblical prophecy is not prediction, it's preparation.

Spend some time in the word: Read 1 Thessalonians chapters 4 & 5

TALK ABOUT IT

What has been your attitude toward Jesus' return in the past? Fear, confusion, anticipation, hope? What do you think has contributed or shaped that view?

What stood out to you about this message specifically. In other words, if the pastor were to preach it again, what would you hope would be included.

Which of the promises of Christ do you cling to the most? Promise of His return? Promise to be with you in difficult times? Promise of spreading the Gospel? Promise of a prepared place in Heaven?

The Bible says to encourage one another with the truth of Christ's return. How can you encourage someone with this truth? In what way do you need to be encouraged by it?

ACT ON IT

The end times will see an increase of wickedness — don't let that infect your own hearts. As you see wickedness creeping into your life... Confess it... Repent of it... Put your armor on... and Stand firm! Christ has promised to see you through.

PRAY ABOUT IT

Ask how you can pray to support one another this week and then close in prayer.
