2. Stop looking to other sources besides God

REVIEW IT

Plenty of people would love to guide you through life. But, you want to be guided by God. Maybe you find yourself in a decision dilemma wondering if God's will is just broad or more specific. God's will has a zone. It's framed in by his ways and his works. His sovereign will and his moral will. The more I get to know what god is doing, and what God has said, the better I will discern what God desires for my life.

Two questions to ask to get you into the zone are, "What am I doing that I should stop doing?" and "What am I not doing that I should start doing?" Three things to stop to be led by God: Stop copying a culture that doesn't follow God. Stop looking to other sources besides God. Stop following feelings that are temporary. There things to start to be led by God: Start being willing to be led. Start looking to God's Word. Start asking the Holy Spirit to guide you.

TALK ABOUT IT

- 1. Did the illustration of a fairway and teaching on God's sovereign and moral will make sense to you? Why or why not?
- 2. How can asking the two questions, "What should I stop doing and what should I start doing" help in getting into God's will?
- 3. Which of the three stops stood out to you most?
- 4. Which of the three starts stood out to you most?

ACT ON IT

Ask God, those two questions. What am I doing that I need to stop, and what am I not doing that I need to start? Write down something that comes to mind and then act on it.

PRAY ABOUT IT

Ask how you can pray for a support one another this week and then close in prayer. Consider praying the Lord's prayer (Matthew 6:9-15) "Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us today our daily bread. And forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one."
