REVIEW IT

There are many common threads, illustrations and themes in the Bible. That's one reason the Bible never gets old. You can always find a new thread woven throughout scripture. One of those is the illustration of a doorway. Jesus liked to reference a door as a metaphor. He said he stands at the door and knocks, he opens doors of opportunity, and (in the gospel of John) he declared, "I am the door."

A door can represent the entrance door of salvation, the threshold to fellowship, the passage door of discipleship, the service door of ministry, or the outside door to your mission in life. A door can be an entrance or it can be an exit. It can represent acceptance, or it can represent rejection. There are many implications for the doors in your life, and **every door is a decision**. Here's what we need to know about the doors in our life...
