## **REVIEW IT**

Today, the Christmas story is widely available and in many languages. But, when these events actually occurred, most people in the world completely missed them. Very few people got to be there when God came to earth. This begs the questions: Why these people? What made them so special? The truth is, they were not special at all. They were normal people just like us whom God chose to use and bless. How can I be blessed like those in the Christmas account?

- 1. Like Joseph, cooperate with God's plan for your life
- 2. Like the shepherds, celebrate that God is here with us
- 3. Like Mary, contemplate continually on God's word
- 4. Like the wise men, commit my time & gifts to Christ

Spend some time in the word... Read Luke chapter 2

## **TALK ABOUT IT**

- How do we see Joseph responding to God's command? What has God been prompting you to do?
  How could you make this a priority? How might this clear the way for God to act? Does it matter if you
  understand it or not?
- Revisit Luke 2:8-15. Even though the shepherds were of the lowest status, an angel of the Lord appeared to them to announce Good News for all people. How did knowing God was near affect the shepherds? In what ways will you respond to the Good News this Christmas?
- Imagine for a moment you are Mary, scared, young, and being told by an angel that you're going to
  give birth to God's Son! How would you have reacted? Scripture tells us she treasured God's words to
  her. In what ways does God prompt us to contemplate, or think more deeply about his Word?
- The wise men were educated and intelligent people of their time, and they followed God's star to find his promised Messiah. In what ways have you sought Jesus in your life?

## **ACT ON IT**

What are you giving Jesus for his birthday this Christmas? It's easy to think he already has everything—but he doesn't have your heart if you haven't yet given it to him—or your faith, trust, love, loyalty...he doesn't have whatever it is you are holding back. What are some things or heart attitudes you can give him? How will you go about it?
