1. Accept their completely

<u>Do not be conformed to this world</u>, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect.

#### 2. Affirm their value constantly

"But don't be afraid of those who threaten you. For the time is coming when everything that is covered will be revealed, and all that is secret will be made known to all. 27 What I tell you now in the darkness, shout abroad when daybreak comes. What I whisper in your ear, shout from the housetops for all to hear!

28 "Don't be afraid of those who want to kill your body; they cannot touch your soul. Fear only God, who can destroy both soul and body in hell. 29 What is the price of two sparrows—one copper coin? But not a single sparrow can fall to the ground without your Father knowing it. 30 And the very hairs on your head are all numbered. 31 So don't be afraid; you are more valuable to God than a whole flock of sparrows. Three ways to affirm their value:

Visual Attention, Physical Affection, Verbal Appreciation

#### 3. Trust them with <u>responsibility</u> increasingly

"Whoever can be trusted with a little can also be trusted with a lot. And if you cannot be trusted with things that <u>belong to someone else</u>, who will give you things of your own?"

- Resilience

#### 4. Correct without condemning

For the Lord corrects those he loves, just as a father corrects a child in whom he delights.

Proverbs 3:12 (NLT)

Punishment = Penalty for the past Discipline = Correction for the future

A refusal to correct is a refusal to love; love your children by disciplining them. Proverbs 13:24 (MSG)

Don't use foul or abusive language. Let everything you say be good and helpful, so that your words will be an encouragement to those who hear them.

Ephesians 4:29 (NLT)

#### 5. Love them <u>fiercely</u> and <u>unconditionally</u>

Be kind and loving to each other, forgiving each other just as God forgave you in Christ. Ephesians 4:32 (NIV)

Love knows no limit to its endurance, no end to its trust, no fading of its hope; it can outlast anything. 1 Corinthians 13:7 (Ph)
