Jesus told him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one can come to the Father except through me. John 14:6 (NLT)
For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life through Christ Jesus our Lord. Romans 6:23 (NLT)
But God showed his great love for us by sending Christ to die for us while we were still sinners. Romans 5:8 (NLT)
To all who <u>believed</u> him and <u>accepted</u> him, he gave the right to become children of God. ¹³ They are reborn—not with a physical birth resulting from human passion or plan, but a birth that comes from God. John 1:12-13 (NLT)
