#### Motherhood takes on different forms.

- She helps the needy and poor.
- She takes care of her servants (those who are not her own children).
- She can set Godly examples.
- Titus 2:3-5 (NLT)

### Godly mothers reveal God's unconditional love - they nurture.

• While men tend to teach us to work hard (as do women), women teach us our value is not attached to our accomplishments.

# Godly women teach us faithfulness and humility.

- Not because they are less valuable but because they love more.
- By laying down their rights for the good of others.
- 1 Peter 3:1-5 (NLT)

#### Godly women have courage:

- To lay down their lives.
- To say no to the world's standards.
- To forgive.
- · Godly women keep us safe.
- Godly women keep us whole.
- Proverbs 31:25 (NLT)

Our role: to honor and celebrate women – because the ripple effect establishes our future.
