Review:

- Week 1: The Soils—the seed is sown, and the soil receives the seed or not.
- Week 2: The Pearl of Great Price—Salvation is worth everything you have.
- **Week 3:** The Pharisee and the Tax Collector—Salvation by grace through faith—the gospel.

THIS WEEK'S PARABLE: LUKE 13:1-9 (NIV)

- The context: The people brought up some current situations/events.
- The thought at the time was about why bad or good things happen.
- Jesus is talking to the Jews. This is a warning about what would happen to all the Jews. (See *Matthew 24* (NIV)) It did happen in AD 70!

1. GOD WANTS REPENTANCE, AND REPENTANCE PRODUCES FRUIT!

- Notice repentance is the key. Faith produces repentance—fruit is consistent with repentance.
 - Metanoia: to have another mind

REMINISCENT OF JOHN THE BAPTIST: MATTHEW 3:7-10 (NIV)

REPENTANCE IN SCRIPTURE: THE GOSPEL PREACHED FOR THE FIRST TIME.

- ACTS 2:36-40 (NIV)
 - Repentance is a change of heart that leads to a change of attitude and direction.
 - We were building a monument to ourselves; now we live a new life of spiritual fruit.

A SPIRIT/HEART OF REPENTANCE PRODUCES FRUIT OF RIGHTEOUSNESS (see also JAMES 2:14,17 (NIV)).

• 2 CORINTHIANS 7:9-11 (NIV)

THE PARABLE: GOD EXPECTES SPECIFIC FRUIT IN KEEPING WITH REPENTANCE.
